

Kevan N4XL gave an excellent presentation on crimping and weatherproofing Coax.

Di N4DLL is coordinating our participation in the 24 June field Day. According to ARRL this years field day should be focused on family & fun, inclusion of nonhams, simply getting on the air, operations in a field environment with the ability to sustain these operations over a period of time. A lengthily discussion followed concerning locations. Considerations were available electricity, ability to run generators, cost (shouldn't be any) bbq's, antennas & overhead cover. Locations considered were Cambridge Park, Grace Street park, Magnolia Park, Greenwood State Park, Burton Center & Coronaca Baptist Church among others. No decision was made at this meeting. Dave KY4GM contacted Jamie Parrish (Greenwood County Emergency Management Coordinator) for her input and assistance on waving any fees. On May 16, the Grace Street Park was selected for our field day, all fees were waived. Please contact Di, N4DLL on what equipment you will be willing to bring. Rigs, antennas, generator, tables, chairs, overhead cover, bbq etc. or your willingness to contact short demonstrations on CW, radio ops etc.

Dave KY4GM suggested forming a membership committee who would function as a source of standardized information for those interested in obtaining a ham license, and recruitment of future members. Discussion followed but no action was taken at this time

#### WHY ARE YOU CALLING, YOU ARE SO CLOSE?

Hello fellow FT8 enthusiasts, I would first like to thank fellow FT8ers for all the contacts, since I started with FT8 back in Nov-2022. I also need to thank all for getting me more involved with E-confirmaton (QSL) methods. Since starting FT-8, I have gone from just my personal log, to updating my LoTW on a daily basis rather than once every so often. I added E-QSL (Though not a big fan) and QRZ (Which I love). If some of you don't use these, I would recommend that you look into them, they are a great way to confirm your contacts fast.

So thanks again to all. There is something else I wanted to say. I know how excited I get when my WSJT contact window turns Aqua Blue (My color choice for someone trying to make contact). I try to answer every request as soon as possible, no matter where it is coming from. I believe that if they are calling me then they must need something that my call sign provides.

I, myself, am an avid county hunter. Prior to FT8 I had worked 3014 of the 3077 US counties. You can only imagine how bored I'd become trying to work a new county, FT8 changed things. I went from barely being on the air to being on nearly every day. I started with chasing DXCC to WAS and now US counties. Thanks to Grid-Tracker, I have worked over 1000 counties and confirmed, using E-qsl, LoTW and QRZ, around 900.


