Karen Sexton, a teacher at Mathews Elementary School, and her grand-children, visited our GARS Morse code booth at the October 21<sup>st</sup> Lakelands iMagine STEAM Festival. After seeing how excited her grand-children were about participating in the Morse code activities, she asked if the club would be willing to come and talk about Morse code with her 4<sup>th</sup> grade science students who were learning about different forms of communication.

So, bright and early Monday morning, October 30<sup>th</sup>, W3RXF (George Crane), KN4SIK (Jack Whitt), N4WDC (David Collins), KJ4JGP (Mitch Litwer), N4DLL (Di Litwer), and David's son, Sean Collins, set up equipment and materials in Ms. Sexton's classroom in preparation for teaching four classes, approximately 80 fourth grade children, about Morse Code as a form of communication that is still used today. After a brief introduction to the GARS members, and a quick discussion about the means of communication on the Titanic, Mitch gave the students a short lesson on energy and electromagnetic waves. This was followed by a demonstration of electromagnetic waves using handheld radios. Students inside the classroom then got to try talking on the handhelds to students outside the classroom.

Students then got down to the business of learning about and practicing Morse code. Each student was given a card with the Morse Code on it and were required to translate their first name from alphabet letters into the dots and dashes of Morse code. As students finished this task, they were directed to one of the three tables with Morse code keys, manned by George, Jack, and David. Here the students practiced keying their names and SOS in Morse code.

When not tapping out their names in Morse code, the students were making bead bracelets with their names in Morse code with Sean or Di, as well as touring a technology "mini-museum" of different eras of Ham radios and learning about Samuel Morse with Mitch.

Each class ended with the students watching a short video clip of the Titanic sending SOS SOS CQD CQD in Morse code, and noting how the signal became progressively weaker and more difficult to hear until it finally stopped in mid SOS.

A huge thank you to George, Jack, and David Collins for manning the Morse code tables with the keys, Mitch for providing the lesson on electromagnetic waves with the handheld radios and manning the technology "mini-museum," and Sean for helping 80 children string bead bracelets with their names in Morse code.
