The passing of Doug Anderson W4NWS, forwarded by Kevan Nason, N4XL

NWS Columbia's Observing Program Leader (OPL) Doug Anderson passed away Thursday morning after suffering an unexpected serious health condition on Monday.

He grew up in Oregon. Doug enlisted in the Air Force in the early 1980s, served on active duty for 24 years, and retired as a Master Sergeant. His military service included deployments to Kuwait during Operation Desert Storm, twice to Korea for Army support, Eielson Air Force Base Alaska, and Shaw Air Force Base in Sumter, South Carolina. His last duty position was as a Detachment Chief and his military decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal. Doug served as a DOD technician at Shaw Air Force Base after his retirement to assist service members with the transition to the weather hub concept of operations. He worked in operations for the Columbia Metropolitan Airport after his position was eliminated by the DOD during sequestration. Doug joined the NWS at the Weather Service Office in Bethel, Alaska in 2013 as a Meteorological Technician. He returned to South Carolina in 2015 as a Hydrometeorological Technician at NWS Columbia.

He received an on station promotion to the OPL position in 2020. He led one of the best OPL programs in the NWS with multiple Holm and Jefferson Award recipients, experimental observing platform demonstrations, and was consistently near the top in paperwork scores. He also served as a workplace violence advocate and received formal recognition from NOAA for his accomplishments and advocacy. Doug served as NWS Columbia's NWSEO Union Steward from 2018 to 2023. He provided essential support and partnership to his Meteorologist -in-Charge during and after the COVID pandemic. He helped address the concerns of employees regarding workplace changes, extensive telework, vaccine mandates, and the return to the office in 2022.

Doug was an avid amateur radio operator and led the office's SKYWARN Spotter Program. His last day in office was hosting volunteers during the annual SKYWARN Spotter Appreciation Day with more than thirty participants, static exhibits, and multiple tours and presentations.





The Greenwood Amateur Radio Society (GARS) VE team led by Tommy Owens K4XB held a Ve testing session on December 5, 2023.

The class is free. The class will be taught virtually, using the Zoom software. Class size is limited to 25 students. This class will also be streamed live and recorded for later viewing on the W4EEY YouTube channel.

Instructors will be Gary W4EEY and Dave KE4EA.


